

## Rhythm Etude 16

A sixteenth note has a value of  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a beat; therefore 4 sixteenths fit into the space of a quarter note, 2 fill the space of an eighth note and a dotted eighth is equal to 3 sixteenths. Use syllables to subdivide the beat: 1-e-a, 2-e-&-a, etc. Play the following etude. Be careful to place each sixteenth note in the exact space allotted to
