David Bowie (8 January 1947 – 10 January 2016) had a phenomenal musical career and success. He also had the opportunity to work with a variety of great bass players. Trevor Bolder (9 June 1950 – 21 May 2013) is one of these bass player that is featured in this ebook. Bolder is at the center of classic albums like *'Hunky Dory'* (1971), *'The Rise And Fall Of Ziggy Stardust And The Spiders From Mars'* (1972), *'Aladdin Sane'* (1973) and *'Pin Ups'* (1973). Other legendary bass players featured here are Willie Weeks, John Deacon, Carmine Rojas and producer Tony Visconti, who have different musical approaches, which you will have the chance to delve deeper into. Last but not least, make sure you check out and listen to Herbie Flowers very inspired bass line for the song 'Space Oddity'. His performance on this song is masterful bass playing. You'll find within these pages, the bass lines for fifteen of David Bowie's greatest songs. Bowie died in New York City on January 10th 2016, two days after his 69th birthday.
