## LESSON #27: GRACE NOTES

Grace notes are musical ornaments, or embellishments, that usually are not part of the piece of music the Grace notes hold no rhythmic value. What they do is add a stylistic component to the music to give character what would normally be played the same by everyone. While grace notes may be added by the composer to account, they are usually added by the performer. In blues bass, grace notes can be a great way to personalize a bend-like approach to any note that you are playing.

## **Execution**

Grace notes can be played with various techniques, including hammer-ons, pull-offs, slides, and bends. Let's take and of these techniques within the same line.
